1. Fees and expenses

1.1 Membership fees (in EUR)

Membership fees for ICC members are as follows from 1 January 2005:

Member organisations	Annual fee in €
Associate members	1000
Small organisations	1000
Big organisations	4000
First year fee	50% of regular membership fee
Reduction for Board members	500 (to be deducted from membership fee for following year, based upon active participation in board activities for the current year)
Discretionary reductions / increases	To be decided by the Board on an ad hoc basis

1.2 Fees for schemes, products and services

Standard fees for all schemes, products or services are to be published for all members. Changes in the scale of fees are to be presented to ICC member organisations at or by the time the General Assembly meets, and shall take effect not less than six months after that date.

1.3 Expenses

All costs incurred by member organisations arising from attendance at the General Assembly, at meetings of the ICC Board or at any other ICC meeting will, unless expressly otherwise stated, be borne by the sending organisations. The only exception being expenses of the Chairperson and ICC Officer(s) / staff, which will be borne by the ICC.

2. Membership

Existing members will be informed and consulted in good time in the case of applications for membership from organisations operating in their region. Individual members do not, however, have the right to veto applications for membership.
